City of Xenia Hosts 2019 “Xenia Job Fair” with Community Partners

Xenia, Ohio (March 12, 2019) - The City of Xenia will host the “**2019 Xenia Job Fair**”, **Wednesday, March 13, 2019**, from 2-5 pm at Xenia High School, 303 Kinsey Road, Xenia, Ohio. The City, in partnership with OhioMeansJobs-Greene County, the Xenia Area Chamber of Commerce, Clark State Community College and Xenia Community Schools, will host 62 companies from different disciplines that are hiring and ready to fill open positions.

City Manager Brent Merriman stated, “A large number of companies have job openings that Xenia area residents can fill.” He added, “We have worked diligently with our job fair partners this year to present an event that will not only highlight employment opportunities in our city and region, but will also include opportunities for graduating Xenia High School seniors.”

The 2019 Xenia Job Fair will also include a special “High School Seniors Only” mini-job fair that will be geared towards employing Xenia High seniors.
