Larry Miller Retires from Xenia Public Service Division

Xenia, Ohio (March 27, 2019)- Xenia Public Service Maintenance employee Larry Miller will retire from the City of Xenia, effective March 28, 2019, after 23 years of service.

Miller began his career with the City of Xenia Public Service and Maintenance Division in the spring of 1995. He had prior experience maintaining infrastructure and the water system of Spring Valley, Ohio while he served as Water Superintendent. Prior to that he graduated from Xenia High School where he had worked in the private sector.
