

CITY OF XENIA, OHIO
ORDINANCE NUMBER 17 – 48

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SOUND COMMUNICATIONS, INC., FOR ACCESS CONTROL AND SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS AT THE XENIA FIRE STATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$48,827.53, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City continues to work toward assuring the physical security and controlled access of all City buildings and locations;

WHEREAS, Sound Communications, Inc., (SCI) is the sole vendor the City is contracted with to install the needed access control and surveillance systems;

WHEREAS, it is Council's desire to get the Fire Stations secured immediately following the imminent completion of the Justice Center; and

WHEREAS, competitive bidding is not required under State law when the purchase consists of services related to information technology that are proprietary or limited to a single source.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF XENIA HEREBY ORDAINS, at least five (5) members of the City Council concurring, that:

Section 1. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency for the reason that there is a need to expedite the installation and update of the Division of Fire's Stations security systems due to the imminent completion of the Justice Center in order to have no gaps between security projects.

Section 2. It is determined that Sound Communications, Inc., is a sole source provider of the needed proprietary information technology and/or programming services and, pursuant to State law, competitive bidding is not required.


Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Sound Communications, Inc., in the amount of forty-eight thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven dollars and fifty-three cents (\$48,827.53) for the installation, programming and updating of access control and surveillance systems at the Xenia Fire Stations.

Section 4. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption, in accordance with Section 5.04 of the City Charter.
