This program has been utilized at XHS and will, hopefully, be leveraged again in the future; and
- WHEREAS,** Dr. Delaney is also a founding Partner Professional in the organization 4CancerWellness whose mission is to enhance the care and supportive services for cancer patients and their significant others. 
